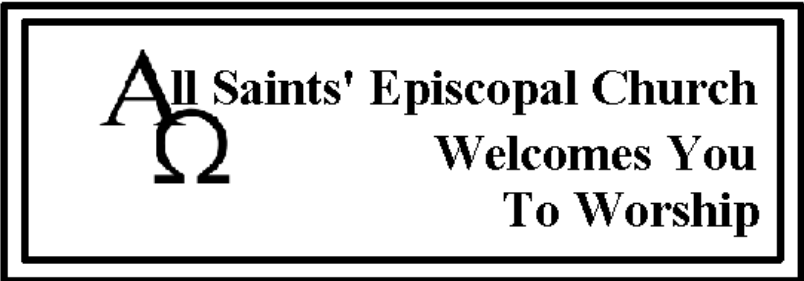

Dear Saints,

Luke's version of the beatitudes is in some respects more of a comment on society than Mathew's. Luke's sermon, for example, blesses the poor, not the poor in spirit. Luke also includes some very strong warnings to those who are well off in society. It's part of his view of a Messiah of social justice. Luke's Christ is the hope of the poor and the representative of the maligned and hated in society.

Of course, in Luke's Gospel, as in all of them, Jesus eventually becomes the hated and maligned of society. It's just that in Luke's story we understand more intensely that he has taken on the identity of those to whom he deliberately reached out. They can identify with his suffering, because Jesus has identified himself with theirs. He became the rejected man of sorrows and died a criminal's death. Yet, his death was not only for the marginalized of society, but for the whole of humanity. ja+
