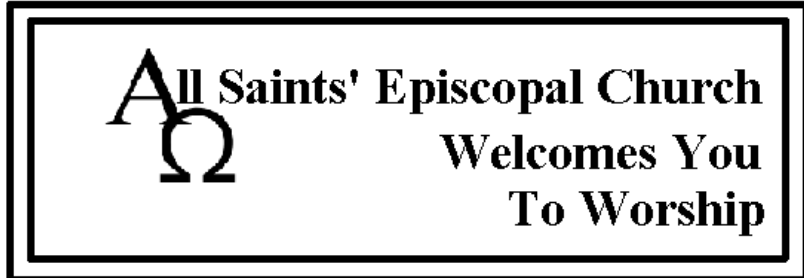

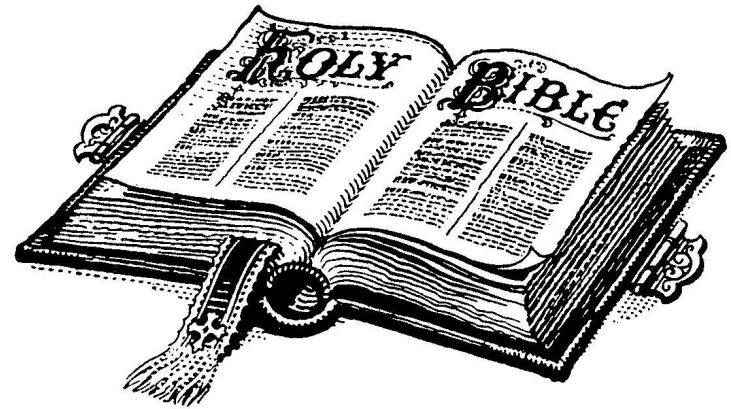

Dear Saints,

This Sunday, I have added another preaching text – the confession of St. Peter. Today was the scheduled celebration of that Confession. I believe it continues the theme of Epiphany by deepening and personalizing the manifestation of the Christ. Peter's words, "You are the Christ, son of the living God," describes an individual, intimate understanding of the identity of Jesus confessed in the body of believers. We have, so far, in Lectionary, dealt with the heavenly manifestation of the Christ to the world. In this scene the revelation is a personal decision articulated in a cooperative setting.

The newly formed group of believers hear, for perhaps the first time, that one of their own believes that Jesus is both the promised Davidic King of Israel and the divine son of God. The private epiphany of Peter becomes an important part of the manifestation of the Christ to ancient Jews as well as the body of believers yet to be born. ja+
