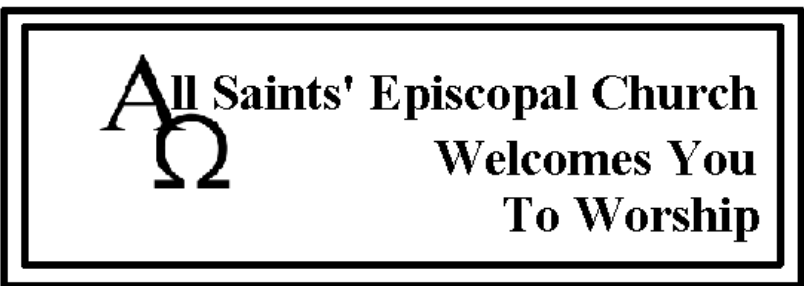

Dear Saints,

Whose stock is up? Whose stock is down? Robert Frost used to ask. He was referring to the reputation of modern poets, but we could ask the same questions of those two famous sisters, Mary and Martha, in today's Gospel reading. Over recent decades, thoughtful Bible readers have see-sawed in their opinion of the sisters. The story seems to favor Mary's listening over Martha's serving. But then came a time when readers began to feel Martha was getting a bad rap, especially since the narrative seems to confine her to traditional feminine roles and then to condemn her for fulfilling them. Lately, many readers have been focusing less on Martha's serving role than on her distracted-ness, or on the resentfulness she shows in asking Jesus to scold her sister. Most recently, we have come to recognize that Mary and Martha each have valid roles and that our task is to unite them in our own life of faith. There is a time to hear the word at the master's feet AND time to bustle about in the kitchen. Service and Study are both important. We need to be able to do both and do them both in the spirit of love. gs+
