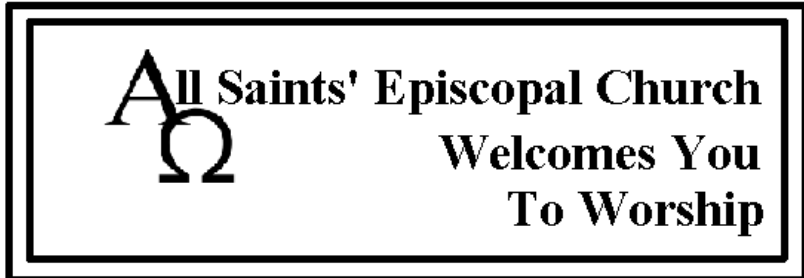

### Dear Saints,

Today we leave the great theological teachings of John and return to the redemption message of Luke. Today's Gospel may sound a bit familiar, because we studied John's version deep into Lent. This Lukian story tells a story of love and forgiveness and questionable friendship. The Pharisee who invites Jesus to his table seems more intent on judging Christ's abilities than entertaining a new friend. The sinner in the story provides tenderness and loving ministry to Jesus. And Jesus himself, generous with his forgiveness, reveals his very human appreciation, even his need to be treated lovingly. Luke sets his story to be savored for its complexity, examined for its depth, and realized for its humane and divine revelation. ja+
