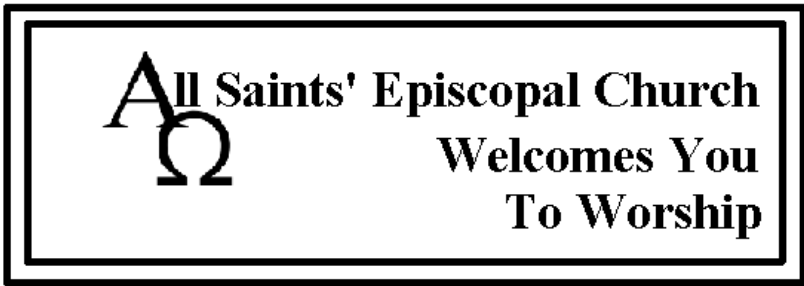

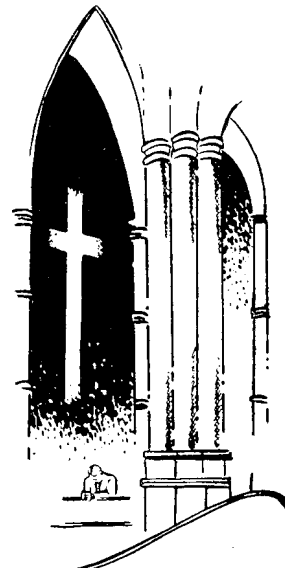

Dear Saints,

As we edge even closer to the story and fire of Pentecost, it seems that the Lectionary for the past weeks would have us carry several messages along. To truly be part of the Pentecost event we must remember a few things...

First, that Jesus the Christ is alive! Spreading the good news of a dead Messiah doesn't work for Christianity. We live in the love of living God--Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Second, according to John we are to equate love with humility, forgiveness and obedience. Christ's farewell discourse teaches us, also, that love is really the only commandment that makes sense.

Third, with the forgoing knowledge imbedded in our hearts, we can expect to be equipped to do all that good news spreading. We can also expect to be frightened to have such capability and such responsibility.

Lastly....Remember, the fear is normal, salvation is available to everyone, the power of Holy Spirit is of God's love, and love is the good news about the kingdom of heaven inside you and all around you and spreading before you. ja+
